#### **From Baltimore**

Merge onto I-95 N toward New York (Portions Toll). Take the MD-22 exit - Exit number 85-toward ABERDEEN/CHRCHVILLE. Keep LEFT at the fork in the ramp. Turn LEFT onto MD-22 W/ABERDEEN TRWY/CHRUCHVILLE RD. Continue to follow MD-22 W/CHURCHVILLE RD. Turn RIGHT onto LONG DR. Left onto GILBERT RD. End at 740 GILBERT RD. ABERDEEN, MD

#### **From New York**

Take the I-95 S/TURNPIKE SOUTH exit. Merge onto I-95 S via the exit - on the left toward CARS ONLY (Portions Only). I-95 S becomes NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE S (Portions Toll) Merge onto I-95 S via the exit - on the left - toward BALTIMORE (Portions Toll). Take the MD-22 exit-exit number 85-toward CHURCHVILLE/ABERDEEN. Turn Right onto MD22/CURCHVILLE. Turn RIGHT onto LONG DR. Left onto GILBERT RD. End at 740 GILBERT DR. ABERDEEN, MD.
