#### **Directions To APG Entrance Gate:**

From Baltimore take I-95 North to exit 80  
(Riverside/Churchville)

Take MD 543 South

Take US 40 East

Take MD 715 to the APG Visitor Center.

*(if you don't have a contractor badge or Gov ID you  
will need to go to the Visitor Center at this entrance)*

#### **Once through the APG entrance gate, you will be on Maryland Blvd.**

At the 3rd blinking light, bear to the right,  
you will now be on Aberdeen Blvd

Proceed through 3 traffic lights until the road divides.

At the Y, bear left on Long's Corner Road

Bear left again on Plumb Point Loop East  
*(golf course will be on the left)*, which leads  
directly to the Top of the Bay *(Building 30)*.
