Directions To APG Entrance Gate:

From Baltimore take I-95 North to exit 80
(Riverside/Churchville)

Take MD 543 South

Take US 40 East

Take MD 715 to the APG Visitor Center.

*(if you don't have a contractor badge or Gov ID you
will need to go to the Visitor Center at this entrance)*

Once through the APG entrance gate, you will be on Maryland Blvd.

At the 3rd blinking light, bear to the right,
you will now be on Aberdeen Blvd

Proceed through 3 traffic lights until the road divides.

At the Y, bear left on Long's Corner Road

Bear left again on Plumb Point Loop East

(golf course will be on the left), which leads

directly to the Top of the Bay (Building 30).
